Godly Play: Baptism

In this lesson we learn that Baptism is full initiation by water and the Holy Spirit into the Church. For Christians, this rite is the gateway into the family of families we call the Church. We ask the children to remember or look forward to the day of their baptism by lighting candles from the light of the Christ Candle, since this is also the day they receive their "light."

Bringing Godly Play Home: If your student has been baptized, talk to them about that day and show pictures if you have them. Talk about *when* and *why* they were baptized. If they have not been baptized, talk about any other baptism they may have seen: *who, when,* and *why.*

Toddler Time will be held on Wednesday mornings from 8:30-10:00am for ages 4yrs old and younger. Too wet and cold for the park? Come join us in the St. James Fellowship Hall for an open playtime. Parents have a chance to socialize with other parents and enjoy free coffee while their children play.
