Godly Play: *The Great Family*

We continue to seek the elusive presence of God. God was present at creation, blessing all that was made. Noah walked with God and was led by God's presence to build the ark that preserved life. Now Abraham and Sarah discover that God is present everywhere, putting their lives on the line to test the promises of God.

Bringing Godly Play Home: This is another good lesson to ask the wondering questions listed last week or to just ask "I wonder what the story today was about?" Then just listen. This is not to quiz the children on what they may or may not recall, but to be quietly present as they share their own experience. Remember that by just listening you are supporting the formation of young, sometimes very young, theologians.
