For Communion Sunday, children will begin in the service and hear the story with the entire congregation. They will be taken downstairs for their work time and then will return for communion.


LECTIONARY TEXTS

Skookum Kids is one of the local agencies that St. James supports financially. Skookum is doing wonderful work in our community, helping children in urgent need of foster homes. In the past year, their accomplishments include:

- More than 70 children have been given emergency shelter
- 7 new families were trained and licensed for the important job of foster parenting
- 11 children exited one of their foster homes to reunify with their families
- 9 children were adopted by their foster family

The cost is \$70 per person which will cover the cost of the affair, while all proceeds from the auction will go to SK's program needs. 
