

PSALM 27

Refrain

- 1 The LORD is my light and my salvation; whom then shall I fear? the LORD is the strength of my life; of whom then shall I be afraid?
- When evildoers came upon me to eat up my flesh, it was they, my foes and my adversaries, who stumbled and fell.
- 3 Though an army should encamp against me, yet my heart shall not be afraid;
 - and though war should rise up against me, yet will I put my trust in the LORD.
- 4 One thing have I asked of the LORD; one thing I seek; that I may dwell in the house of the LORD all the days of my life;
 - to behold the fair beauty of the LORD, to seek God in the temple. Refrain
- 5 For on the day of trouble the LORD shall shelter me in safety; the LORD shall hide me in the secrecy of the holy place and set me high upon a rock.
- 6 Even now the LORD lifts up my head above my enemies round about me.

Therefore I will offer in the holy place an oblation with sounds of great gladness;
I will sing and make music to the LORD. *Refrain*

The refrain for this psalm, drawn from Psalm 27:14, comes from the ecumenical Community of Taizé in France and is most effective when sung in parts. With repeated singing, it can also be used by itself as a contemplative prayer and is especially appropriate in Advent.

- 7 Hearken to my voice, O LORD, when I call; have mercy on me and answer me.
- 8 You speak in my heart and say, "Seek my face." Your face, LORD, will I seek.
- 9 Hide not your face from me, nor turn away your servant in displeasure.

You have been my helper; cast me not away; do not forsake me, O God of my salvation.

- 10 Though my father and my mother forsake me, the LORD will sustain me. *Refrain*
- 11 Show me your way, O LORD; lead me on a level path, because of my enemies.
- 12 Deliver me not into the hand of my adversaries, for false witnesses have risen up against me, and also those who speak malice.
- 13 What if I had not believed that I should see the goodness of the LORD in the land of the living!
- 14 O tarry and await the LORD's pleasure; be strong, and the LORD shall comfort your heart; wait patiently for the LORD. Refrain
